Application Deadline: April 21, 2023

The Morrow County Chamber of Commerce will be awarding (1) \$1000 scholarship and (2) \$500 scholarships. These will be one-time scholarships that will be paid to the student upon proof of completion including 1st semester transcripts or certificate. Documentation must be provided to the chamber no later than March 1, 2024. Funds may be used for tuition, books, room and board, or other expenses related to education.

Eligibility Requirements:

- The student must be a graduating senior
- The student must be a resident of Morrow County
- The student must attend a Morrow County School (students enrolled at Tri-Rivers or Pioneer through a Morrow County School District may also apply)
- The student must plan to attend a college or university, trade school, or vocational training
- Students are encouraged to apply regardless of GPA.
- The student must complete the application form, including an essay, list of activities, and a recommendation from a guidance counselor, teacher, or civic, religious or volunteer leader
