

## Morrow County Township Association Scholarship

The Morrow County Township Association Scholarship is a \$500 scholarship offered to a senior who resides in Morrow County. This scholarship will be awarded to a student who plans to continue his/her education at any form of post-secondary institution (four-year, two-year, career training, etc).

Applications for the Morrow County Township Association Scholarship must be mailed to Morrow County Township Association, PO Box 417, Mount Gilead, OH 43338. Applications must be postmarked by April 30. All materials for the application must be mailed as a packet. If additional space is needed to answer the questions completely, please add additional sheet(s).

The award will be payable for tuition upon a paid receipt from the post-secondary institution. The recipient will submit this to the Morrow County Township Association for reimbursement. This must be used within 16 months after graduation from high school.

Award will be based on community service, leadership qualities, and quality of character. Award is not heavily based on your GPA. An interview in early May may be requested.
