



FAFSA Night Checklist



Before the FAFSA Night

Go to Studentaid.gov and create an account

- If this is your first time filing a FAFSA, you must create a Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID) to manage your account and information

Here is what you will need:

- Name (exactly as it appears on your Social Security card if you have one)
- Date of birth
- Email address
- Social Security number (if you have one)

Bring with you to FAFSA Night

Gather Personal Information: Students (and parents, if the student is a dependent, and student spouses—if applicable) will need to provide a Social Security Number (SSN). If a student spouse, parent, or stepparent does not have an SSN, they can still register for an FSAID. If the student has a driver's license, they will need to provide that number. Non-citizens should have their Alien Registration Number handy.

Dependent Students will need to invite their parent to input their information so you will need the following information:

Parent Birthdate

Parent Social Security Number

Parent Email Address

Records of Child Support Received: Have information handy on child support received, which is considered untaxed income.

Bank Statements and Investment Records: This includes records of the student's (and the parents', if applicable) bank accounts, stocks, bonds, real estate (not including the family home), and other investments.

List of Schools: FAFSA applicants should have a list of schools the student is applying to or attending, as they will need to list these on the FAFSA application. Each school has a unique 6 digit school code that can be used.
