### Things to remember:

- 1) If needed, you can take summer classes to make up for failed credits. Even if you intend on taking the failed courses in the summer, you must schedule the courses for the upcoming year. After you pass the summer course the guidance department will then change your schedule.
- 2) You must schedule all four core courses: English, Math, Science, Social Studies. This is flexible your senior year if you have met all graduation requirements. It is, however, highly recommended if you are planning post-secondary education of any kind.
- 3) Seniors-Keep in mind that you must have at least five classes. (Each CCP class counts as two, Senior Capstone Study can count for up to three high school classes, however it cannot count towards athletic eligibility.)
- 4) You may not schedule more than one study hall or PE each semester.
- 5) College Credit Plus paperwork for Highland (Verification of meeting attendance/ Letter of Intent Paperwork- EVERY year) is due April 1<sup>st</sup>. If you need to test to be accepted, you will need to travel to MTC to take the Accuplacer by May 1<sup>st</sup>. Applications to MTC are due no later than May 1<sup>st</sup>.
