Graduation Rehearsal -

You <u>must</u> attend rehearsal in order to participate in the graduation ceremony. Rehearsal will begin immediately following the senior breakfast. **Do not be late!**

Dress Code for Graduation-

Students- Look presentable, professional. Examples: Dress pants (no blue jeans), dress shirt, skirt/blouse, dress slacks, socks, and dress shoes. Students will also wear their graduation cap and gown (tassel on the right side). **No decorations on your cap or gown.** If you do not follow these directions, you will be sent home to change.
